<b>Skills</b>	Practice flashcards daily (colors, numbers, shapes, letters)
	Do 1 worksheet/activity from home-school packet

<b>Reading</b>	Labeling Your Home: Label the refrigerator, the door, the bath, the garage – label whatever you can think of. As your child sees these words around your home, they become more familiar. This is perfect literacy activity to prepare your child for reading. Go around your home and have your child read words with your help. (Give your child hints by saying the first letter sound, etc.)

<b>Language Arts</b>	Letter matching: Write each letter of your child's name on a post-it note (1 letter per post-it), then write your child's name on a piece of paper. Have your child match the letters on the post-its to the letters written on the paper to spell their name.

<b>Writing</b>	On a large piece of paper, help your child to draw a road (can be straight, or full of turns). Using a toy car, have your child "drive" on the road staying in the lines.

<b>Math</b>	Number search: Write the numbers 1 to 10 on individual sticky notes. Post them around your house. Ask your child to search for the sticky notes and then place them in the correct order.
